



Travelling to the School of Chemistry

By Car

On many of our sequence of post-applicant visit days free car parking for UCAS visitors is available at Woodhouse Moor (please check the UCAS days website for details). When this facility is not available (see website) then we recommend parking at the multi-storey car park 5 minutes walk from the School. Unfortunately parking on campus is not available with the exception of those with a disabled blue badge permit. Please contact us for further details in these cases. Please note that 'sat-nav' systems have a habit of leading drivers through the very centre of Leeds which, while direct, is not necessarily the easiest route. We advise you to consider the routes below.

M1 from the South

- From the M1 follow the signs for M621 (Leeds Centre)
- Follow the M621 towards Leeds keeping in the correct lane for Junction 2
- Exit at Junction 2 (not 2A) signposted A643
- At the roundabout turn right (3rd exit) signed Wetherby A643 (A58)

...continue

M62 from the East

- At Junction 29 of the M62 turn onto the M1 North
- From the M1 follow the signs for M621 (Leeds Centre).
- Follow the M621 towards Leeds keeping in the correct lane for Junction 2
- Exit at Junction 2 (not 2A) signposted A643
- At the roundabout turn right (3rd exit) signed Wetherby A643 (A58)

...continue

M62 from the West

- Exit the M62 at Junction 27 signposted Leeds M621
- Follow the M621 towards Leeds
- Exit at Junction 2 Signposted Wetherby A643 (A58)
- At the roundabout take the first exit signed Wetherby A643 (A58)

...continue

...directions from junction 2 of M621

- From the Wetherby A643 (A58) exit of the roundabout at Junction 2 continue along the dual carriage way towards Leeds. The road will transform into the A58.
- After 1.2 miles you will approach a major interchange. Position in the middle or right hand lane (City Centre A58)
- Follow the signs and lanes marked City A58M around the interchange
- After leaving the interchange, stay in the right hand lanes (signposted A58M City Centre) which lead onto the A58M inner ring road
- After ~1 mile, shortly after passing through a long underpass, take the exit marked Skipton A660 on a faded blue sign overhead

For parking on Woodhouse Moor

Stay in the left hand lane marked Skipton A660 // At the traffic lights bear left and then at the next traffic lights turn right onto Woodhouse Lane // Drive up Woodhouse Lane past the University and the Parkinson Building with its large white tower // Keep in the left hand lane next to the bus lane and follow the road to the left (the School of Chemistry is on the left just after the Parkinson Building for future reference) // Stay in the right hand lane when the bus lane terminates and go straight on at the traffic lights passing the Library pub on the left // After 500m turn right through the first gap in the dual carriage way // The Woodhouse Moor parking is then on the left after 50m.

For parking in the multi-storey car park

Stay in the right hand lane after exiting the A58M inner ring road // At the traffic lights perform a U-turn (signed City) and take the left hand lane (Car Park) // As the lane splits stay in the car park lane on the right.

From the North via the A1

- Exit the A1M at Junction 44 (A64) and take the A64, direction Leeds
- After ~5 miles you will enter the outskirts of Leeds and reach a roundabout
- Take the first exit (A6120 Ring road, City Centre (A64))
- After 0.5 miles take at the next roundabout take the 3rd exit (A64 City Centre)
- After 0.5 miles at the major intersection (Kwik Fit on left) go straight on (City Centre A64)
- Follow the City Centre A64 signs for 3.5 miles, and continue onto the A64M
- Continue on to the A64M (A58M)
- Just after a short underpass, take the exit A660, Skipton : Universities
- Stay in the right hand lane of the slip road and at the next junction turn right following the signs for Skipton A660 onto Woodhouse Lane
- Continue Up Woodhouse Lane

For parking on Woodhouse Moor

Drive up Woodhouse lane past the University and the Parkinson Building with its large white tower // Keep in the left hand lane next to the bus lane and follow the road to the left (the School of Chemistry is just on the left just after the Parkinson Building for future reference) // Stay in the right hand lane when the bus lane terminates and go straight on at the traffic lights passing the library pub on the left
After 500m turn right through the first gap in the dual carriage way. The Woodhouse Moor parking is then on the left after 50m.

For parking at the multi-storey car park

After crossing the inner ring road turn right (Signed Motorway Multi-storey) // At the next lights turn right and stay in the car park lane to enter the car park.



From the North West via the A65

- Follow the A65 towards Leeds
- At Burley in Wharfedale, take the A660 (signed Leeds)
- Continue on the A660 towards Leeds
- Shortly after entering the suburb of Adel you will reach a major roundabout at the junction with the Leeds outer ring road. Go straight over the roundabout (Signposted City Centre A660)
- Follow this road (Otley Road) into Leeds.
- After ~1.5 miles the bus lane will disappear, take the left hand lane
- Go straight on at both sets of traffic lights and continue over a small hill
- On descending the hill you will reach a set of traffic lights with the Hyde Park pub on the left
- Go straight on at the traffic lights

For parking on Woodhouse Moor

Turn left after 250m to the Woodhouse Moor car park facility.

For parking at the multi-storey car park

Continue straight along the dual carriageway // Go straight on at the next set of traffic lights (Library pub on right) // At the next junction keep in the left hand lane and go straight on (Car Parks, Civic Hall) // Stay in the left hand lane and at the next set of lights go straight on (York A64M) // Just after the lights the left lane splits – follow the car park lane which leads to the multi-storey car park.

Walking directions from the Woodhouse Moor parking area

Walk down Woodhouse Lane back towards the University. Continue passing the Library pub on your right and the Eldon pub on your left. Shortly after the Eldon, cross the road at the pedestrian crossing. Continue down Woodhouse Lane. The entrance to the School of Chemistry can be found just after the road bends to the right.

Walking directions from the multi-storey car park

Leave the car park on level 5 and turn right and walk up the road past the large new 'rusty' tower which is on the left hand side. You will be able to see the white tower of the University Parkinson Building over the top of the houses to the left. Keep walking straight up this road passing the Leeds Student Medical Practice. You will then reach St. Marks Road with the Leeds College of Art and Design on the right. The School of Chemistry entrance is diagonally opposite on the other side of the junction.

By Train

Leeds City Station links regularly to all major UK cities. You can get from the railway station to the campus on foot or by bus.

From Leeds City Station on foot

The University campus is a pleasant twenty minute walk from the station.

- Come out of the station into City Square
- With the Queens Hotel behind you, walk straight up Park Row
- Continue up Park Row until the first major junction - The Headrow
- Turn right and walk along The Headrow past The Light shopping centre on your left
- At the end of The Light centre turn left up Woodhouse Lane
- Follow this road up, passing Morrisons supermarket on your right, Leeds Metropolitan University on your left - and the Dry Dock boat pub on an island on your right! The University campus begins in another 50 metres or so on your left
- Carry on up Woodhouse Lane passing the University Parkinson Building, with its large white clock tower. The School of Chemistry is just past the Parkinson Building on the left hand side of the road.

From Leeds City Station by bus

The number 95 bus (LEEDS CITY STATION - BODINGTON HALL) departs from directly outside the rail station. The bus runs approximately every 10 minutes from the rail station and the journey time is around 10 minutes. You should get off the bus at the University steps.

By Air

Leeds Bradford airport is approximately 7 miles away. In addition to international flights there are regular flights to a number of UK airports including Aberdeen, Belfast, Bristol, Exeter, Edinburgh, Glasgow, Isle of Man, London Gatwick, Newquay, Plymouth and Southampton. A taxi from the airport to the University will cost approximately £20.



Leaving Leeds by Car

Leaving Leeds from the Woodhouse Moor facility – A1, M1 and M62

- From the Woodhouse Moor Parking facility turn back towards the University on Woodhouse Lane
- Stay in the left hand lane going past the Library pub
- At the next traffic lights (by Chemistry) go straight on
- After the lights;

For A1 North

- Stay in the left hand lane and follow the signs for the A64M York
- Follow the A64 back to the A1

For M1/M62 via M621

- Stay in the right hand lane (signposted city centre)
- Pass the car park on the left and after a short section of bus lane turn left onto the slip road then join the inner ring road
- Follow the signs for the West A58M
- The motorways (M621, M62, M1) are then clearly signed

Leaving Leeds from the Woodhouse Moor facility – A660/A65

- Turn right out of the Woodhouse Moor Car parking facility away from the University onto Woodhouse lane
- Continue to follow the A660 straight out of Leeds (signed Skipton)

Leaving Leeds from the multi-storey car park - M1/M62 via M621

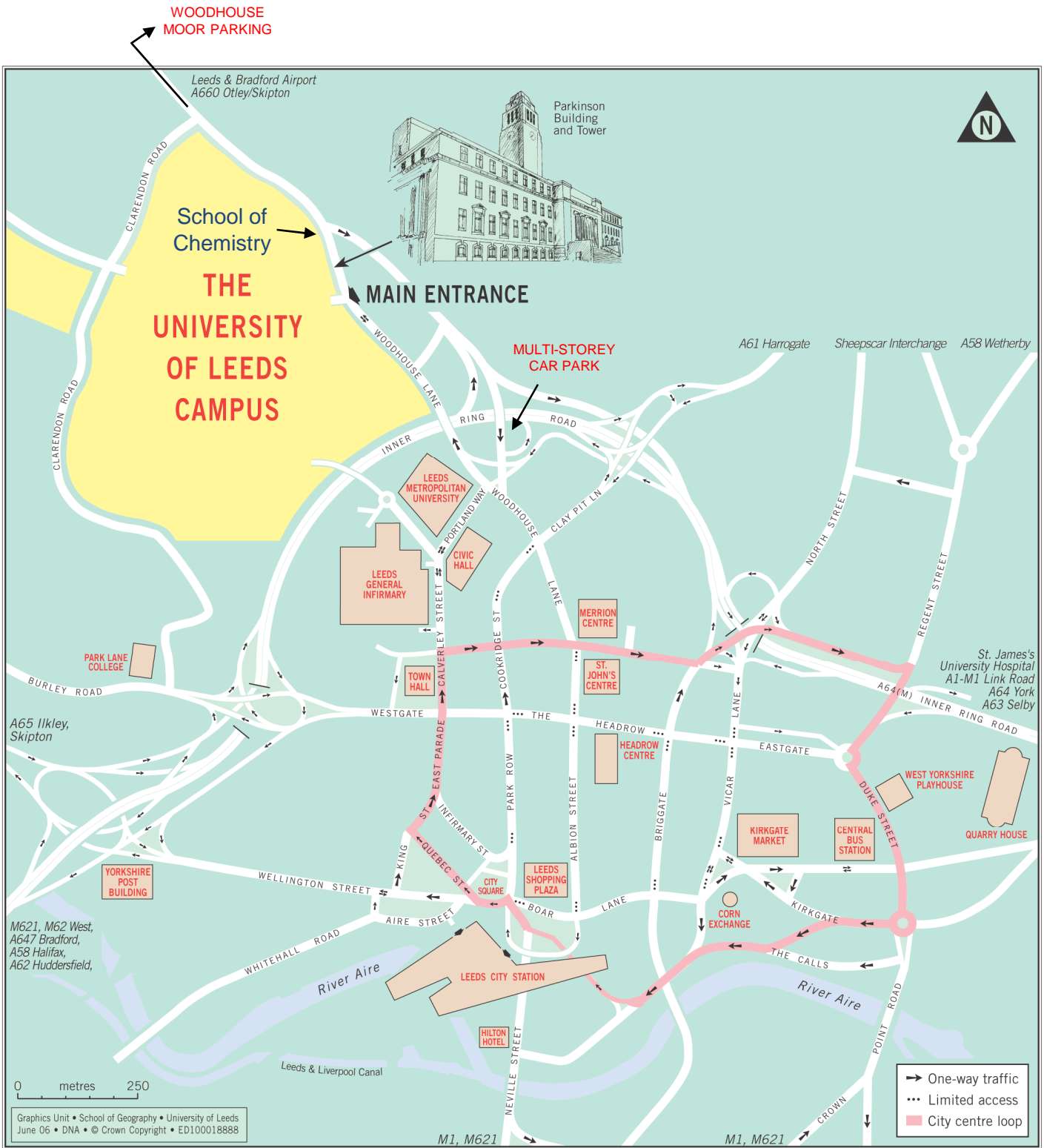
- Use the level 8 or level 12 exits
- At the traffic lights take a right hand U-turn and drive back towards the car park staying in the right hand lane
- Keep right (signposted city centre). Pass the car park on the left and after a short section of bus lane turn left onto the slip road then join the inner ring road
- Follow the signs for the West A58M. The motorways (M621, M62, M1) are then clearly signed

Leaving Leeds from the multi-storey car park - A1 North

- Use the level 7 exit signed A64 (York) and then follow the A64 back to the A1

Leaving Leeds from the multi-storey car park - A660/A65

- Use the level 8 or level 12 exit
- At the traffic lights bear left marked Skipton A660 and then at the next traffic lights turn right onto Woodhouse Lane
- Drive past the University and the School of Chemistry and follow the A660 back out of Leeds
